Requested Fees:

- Provincial legislation does not allow schools to charge a mandatory activity fee. Our PAC and staff believe these programs and activities are important for our students. We are requesting parents continue to pay these fees, so these programs can continue. Our ability to provide these programs will depend on the response from parents. No student will be denied access to a school sponsored program/activity for financial reasons. If circumstances do not permit payment at this point, please contact Mr. Menzies or Mme Jegues.
 - **Optional Cultural Performance and Activity Fee \$30 (max. \$60/family):**
The school district books excellent cultural performances each year for our school and we pay the district \$8 per student for all students enrolled in our school. The activity fee supports various school-wide activities (eg. art fair registration, cross-country registration, swimming program, skating program, gymnastics, etc).
 - **Field Trips:**
Teacher may plan field trips and charge a fee to cover costs (eg. transportation, entry fees, accommodation, food, equipment rentals, etc.).
