# **Your Support Matters**

If you don't feel like you have time to be in an executive position on our PAC, there are still easy ways to support us. **The easiest way is to attend meetings.** 

We generally hold our meetings in the school music room (or online via Microsoft Teams) the third Monday of the month. Meetings start at 6:30 pm and usually only last an hour or so. **We also almost always have a babysitter available so that you don't have to worry about child care.** 

At these meetings, we hear from our Principal, Heather Gobbett, Vice Principal Megan Weir, and occasionally our School Board Trustee, Marianne VanBuskirk. They will give us updates on what is happening around our school and our district. After that, we discuss what monies we have spent, funds to distribute, what upcoming fundraisers we have, Fun Food day update etc.; there is an opportunity for anyone present to bring up anything they would like to discuss.

I cannot stress how informal these meetings are. Everyone has an opportunity to speak as much or as little as they like and have a say in what matters to them. Each parent and guardian at our school is automatically a PAC member, and your thoughts and opinions matter to your children and us.
